

UNION PEDIATRIC ASSOCIATES, PA PATIENT BILL OF RIGHTS

In New Jersey, health care consumers are guaranteed their right to:

- Considerate and respectful care
- Complete information regarding diagnosis, treatment and prognosis
- All information needed to give informed consent for any procedure or treatment
- A second medical opinion
- Refuse to take part in research
- Refuse treatment and be informed of medical consequences
- Confidentiality of medical records and condition
- Participate in all decision about treatment and discharge from a health care facility
- Receive copies of all written medical records (Patient may incur cost of copies)
- An itemized bill and explanation of charges
- Care and treatment without regard to sex, race, color, religion, national origin or source of payment
- Voice grievances and recommend changes in policies and services
- Express complaints about care and services to the management or their designee or to the New Jersey Department of Health
- Be informed of the services available at Union Pediatric Associates
